

## Doorways to Independence



### Home Modification/Repair and Adaptive Equipment Program

Through the Doorways to Independence program, ADAPT Community Network provides home modification services and adaptive equipment to persons with disabilities, the elderly, and the medically frail. Funding is available to cover the cost of modifications that will improve physical access and safety within the home. Home owners, co-op owners, and renters may qualify for assistance. Home Modifications may include, but are not limited to: **wheelchair ramps, stairlifts, grab bars, railings, widening of doorways, safety fences, wheelchair accessible bathrooms, shower chairs, hoist lifts, adaptations for those who are deaf, blind or have low vision.**

#### WHAT WE OFFER

Full project coordination including:

- Home assessments
- Scope of work development
- Obtaining estimates from qualified and licensed vendors/contractors
- Project management

#### ACCESS TO HOME GRANT

- Service available in all five boroughs
- Applicant could be living independently or with family
- Must have a permanent physical disability or have substantial difficulty with ADL's due to aging
- Total household income may not exceed 80% of area median income
- Allocation of funds may vary, however the project cap is 25k

#### FAMILY SUPPORTS AND SERVICES GRANT

- Service available in Queens, Staten Island, Bronx, and Brooklyn
- Applicant must be residing with family
- Must be diagnosed with a developmental disability and be approved for OPWDD services
- There is no income requirement to qualify for this assistance
- Allocation of funds may vary, however project cap is 6k
